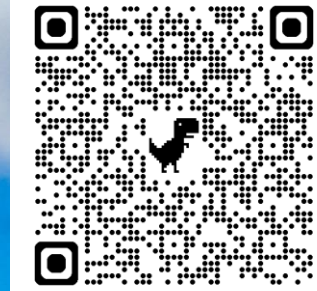


# Call for Native Artists

The American Indian Alaska Native Tourism Association (AIANTA) in partnership with the USDA Forest Service and the Pacific Northwest Trail Association (PNTA), is **requesting proposals** from Native artists to create a new service mark (logo) that will serve as the visual identity of the Pacific Northwest National Scenic Trail (PNT).

- Become part of the PNT's official visual identity.
- Be featured on AIANTA's website and receive a \$2,500 commission!

### Who can apply?

Native artists or tribally endorsed artists from Montana, Idaho, and Washington State.

**Application deadline:** February 28, 2025

### How to apply:

2. In your submission, include:
  - A description of your proposed design approach for the logo.
  - A small portfolio showcasing your previous artwork.
